The **Louis & Mary J. Abstine Scholarship** will be given to residents of Shelby County seeking to obtain or complete a college or professional education.

The **Daniel and Emma Avery Scholarship** will be given to residents of the geographic area encompassed by the Shelbyville News circulation who will be studying journalism or the graphic arts.

The **Marvin Boring Family Scholarship** will be given to high school seniors that have at least one parent that is currently a member of the Carrolton United Methodist Church in Finly.

The **Matt Branson Memorial Scholarship** will be given to a graduating senior from Shelby County enrolled in an accredited Indiana college/university to study Machine Tool & Die.

The **Karol Carwein Elementary Education Scholarship** will be given to a graduating senior from any Shelby County High School pursuing a degree in elementary education.

The **Maurice T. Cherry Family Scholarship** will be given to a graduating senior from any Shelby County High School pursuing a degree in architecture, engineering or another related field of study at a state-supported school in Indiana.

The **Arthur & Hazel McKenney Scholarship** will be awarded to a graduating Shelby County High School senior or past recipient currently attending college and planning to study or currently studying to become a teacher of special needs students, have a minimum 'B' GPA and financial need.

The **Joseph & Laura Plymate Scholarship** will be given to a student pursuing a major in the earth sciences.

The **Laura H. Billman Scholarship** will be given to a Shelbyville High School senior enrolled in a college or university who has participated in school and community activities.

The **Willard & Naomi Maxwell Day Scholarship** will be given to a Shelbyville High School senior enrolled in a college or university to major in the field of education.

The **Bruce C. Douglass Memorial Scholarship** will be given to a graduating senior of Shelbyville High School with demonstrated proficiency in biology or chemistry.

The **Dona Drake Memorial Scholarship** will be given to a Shelbyville High School senior boy or girl who has participated in athletics.

The **Katie Ernstes Scholarship** will be given to a graduating senior from Shelbyville High School with a history of community or extra-curricular activities.

The **Wanda Hindman Memorial Nursing Scholarship** will be given to a graduating Shelbyville high school senior who has demonstrated proficiency in the sciences and who plans to enroll in college. The student must demonstrate a probability of success in college and have a vocational interest in a nursing career.

The **George E. Kent Scholarship** will be given to a Shelbyville High School senior who has been involved in the community, demonstrates good character and citizenship, the ability to succeed in college and satisfactory academic achievement.

The **Mary Platt Oxford Teaching Scholarship** will be awarded to Shelbyville High School seniors that have declared their intent to pursue a degree in teaching and are the highest ranking students to pursue that area of study.

The **Chester G. & Mildred M. Sandman Scholarship** will be awarded to a graduating Shelbyville High School senior who demonstrates financial need, exemplary character, academic promise, at least a B average, and who will be attending an accredited college or university.

The **Charles P. Sindlinger Scholarship Fund** awards scholarships for Shelbyville High School graduates. Students with demonstrated financial need will be given priority.

The **Christopher Graham Spear Memorial Scholarship** will be given to a Shelbyville High School graduating senior who demonstrates financial need.
