ACCELERATED ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

Shelbyville Central Schools provides an accelerated enrichment (AE) program for the high ability student. These classes are designed for students who possess a strong academic aptitude. The curriculum is compacted which means the student moves through basic material more quickly. Classroom activities require active student participation and involvement. Higher levels of thinking will also be emphasized.

Student selection is based on the student's classroom performance, standardized and cognitive ability test scores and the teacher's referral. If you would like to recommend your child for the AE program, please pick up a parent nomination form from your child's school office. Completed forms need to be returned by Friday, April 2, 2010. Students currently participating in the AE program do not need a parent referral.
